Small Disadvantaged Business (SDB):

Veteran-Owned Small Business (VOSB):

does does not *self-certify* as a Small Veteran-owned Business in which 51% of the ownership is held by one or more Veterans (as defined in 38 U.S.C. 101(12) or, in the case of any publicly owned business, 51% or more of the stock is owned by one or more Veterans; and the management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more Veterans.

Service-Disabled Veteran- Owned Small Business (SDVOSB):

does does not *self-certify* as a Small Service-disabled Veteran-owned Business owned by a Service-disabled Veteran or Veterans (see above). To be further classified as Service-Disabled in accordance with 38 U.S.C. 10(12), the Veteran or Veterans must have a disability/or disabilities that are Service connected as defined in 38 U.S.C. 101(16).

Certification is required by an authorized representative verifying the information submitted is true. In accordance with 15 U.S.C 645(d), any person who misrepresents a firm's proper size classification shall (1) be punished by imposition of a fine, imprisonment, or both; (2) be subject to administrative remedies; and (3) be ineligible for participation in programs conducted under the authority of the Small Business Act. An updated Supplier Self-Registration Form must be uploaded in the event of change of ownership and/or small business classification status.
